Our GAA season kicked off on a bitter cold wet night on Friday 1st March with an away game in Tubberclair. Milltown got off to a solid start with points from Frank Mc Loughlin, Conor Dillon and Daire Hynes. Tubberclair replied with a goal and 3 points. Milltown responded with a goal from Ja Boyce to leave us 2 points ahead at the half time whistle. Despite our best efforts Tubberclair dominated the second half to finish on a score line of Milltown 1-6 Tubberclair 1-9.

We had our first home game on Sunday 10th March against Caulry. Eoghan Kenny set the scene scoring a goal in the first five minutes of the game followed by a point from Daire Hynes. 3 points followed by Joe Halligan, Daire Hynes & Joe Kenny to leave Milltown ahead by 4 points at half time. Playing against the wind in the second half didn't determine Milltown with scores from Frank Mc Loughlin, Daire Hynes, Paul Mahon, Joe Halligan & Joe Kenny to walk away with a 9 point win.

On Saturday 23rd March we met a strong Maryland team. It was a hard fought battle that ended in a draw game with a last minute penalty scored by Eoghan Kenny.

Our next game on Sunday 31st March was once again with home advantage against Castledaly. This was a closely fought contest, Milltown dug deep with scores from Sean Somers, Diarmuid Maguire, Conor Dillon, Joe Halligan, Frank Mc Loughlin, Gary Byrne, Eoghan Kenny, Jack Murtagh, Wayne Smtih, Ja Boyce & Luke Gunning, we put another 2 points on the league table with a score line of 2-14 to 1-16.

On Saturday 13th April we travelled to Rochfortbridge to meet a strong St Mary's team, despite Milltown's best efforts with scores from Conor Dillon, Joe Halligan, Eoghan Kenny, Ja Boyce & Luke Gunning we came out on the wrong side of the score line by 2 points.

On Thursday 25th April we met our local rivals Ballynacargy. It was a fast paced game that didn't disappoint, with scores from Sean Somers, Conor Dillon, Joe Halligan, Frank Mc Loughlin, Eoghan Kenny, Jack Murtagh, Ja Boyce & Luke Gunning, Milltown added 2 more points to the league table, Milltown 2-15 Ballynacargy 1-9.

We travelled to Milltownpass on Friday 3rd May, to what was another closely contested game, Milltown persevered and with scores from Frank Mc Loughlin, Eoghan Kenny, Wayne Smith & Luke Gunning Milltown claimed another win, Milltown 2-8 Milltownpass 0-9.

On Sunday 19th May we welcomed our neighbours Ballymore to Milltown to what was a closely contested and exciting game of football. At half time Milltown were leading by one

point despite Ballymore dominating the game. Despite losing Paddy Somers and Paul Heduan to injury, an undeterred Milltown regrouped, with scores from Frank Mc Loughlin, Eoghan Kenny, Joe Kenny, Luke Gunning, Ja Boyce & Daire Hynes, Milltown secured another win. Milltown 0-13 Ballymore 0-10.

On Tuesday 11th June Milltown travelled to Na Dúnta to play their last league game and hopefully secure a place in the Division 2 Final. Both teams were up for battle and fought a hard game, with scores from Paddy Somers, Sean Somers, Conor Dillon, Frank Mc Loughlin, Eoghan Kenny, Wayne Smith, Joe Kenny, Daire Hynes, Ja Boyce & Luke Gunning, Milltown ran out comfortable winners with a score line of 2-15 to 2-06, to secure a place in the Div 2 Final against Castledaly, and put Milltown in the history books, in their 96th year never having played Div 1 football.

Milltown got off to a good start leading by 8 points in the second half with 2 goals from Ja Boyce, followed by points from Eoghan Kenny & Jack Murtagh. An undeterred Castledaly persisted and were leading by 3 points, when a free taken by Conor Dillon was fisted into the back of the net by Ja Boyce, left a well-deserved even score line at the final whistle, Milltown 3-14 Castledaly 4-11.

On Sunday 25th Aug we travelled to Moate, to once again battle for the Division 2 title against Castledaly. Milltown got off to a slow start but kept striving to the final whistle despite scores from Ja Boyce, Frank Mc Loughlin, Jack Murtagh, Eoghan Kenny & Paul Mahon, a determined Castledaly ran out winners at the final whistle winning by 3 points, Milltown 2-15 Castledaly 3-15.

On Sunday 14th July, Milltown's Intermediate Championship Season began on a glorious sunny evening in TEG Cusack Park against Milltownpass. A thrilling first half saw points from Frank Mc Loughlin, Luke Gunning, Conor Dillon, Wayne Smith, Joe Halligan & Jack Murtagh and a penalty from Ja Boyce hammered in the back of the net, left Milltown trailing at the half time whistle by 2 points. On resumption of the game despite a point from Milltownpass to go ahead by 3 points, Milltown battled on to dominate the second half with points from Frank Mc Loughlin & Matthew Gunning, and Ja Boyce rattling the net on 3 more occasions put Milltown firmly in control and walk away with their first Championship win of 2019 with a healthy score line of Milltown 4-12 Milltownpass 1-16.

Westmeath County Teams




